Smoke Alarms

- Do monthly checks
- Test the unit
- Replace batteries if needed
- Clean unit if needed

Carbon Monoxide Detectors

- Do monthly checks
- Test the unit
- Replace batteries if needed
- Clean unit if needed

Filters

- Replace filter, as per manual on <u>Furnace Unit</u>
- Replace or clean filter, as per manual on the <u>Hood Range Unit</u>







Dryer Unit

- Always clean dryer filter after each use. Potential fire source if not cleaned on regular bases
- Yearly complete a check of the dryer vent from dryer unit to outside vent.

Electrical Cords

• Electrical cords should be replaced/removed if frayed or damage in any manner

Fire Extinguisher

- Check to see that its Fully charged, check Pressure Gauge
- Check for irregularities
 - Crack hose lines
 - Nozzle is free from obstructions
 - > Pull Pin is free from obstructions

Escape Plan

- Ensure everyone knows Escape Route Plan in household
- Where the Fire Extinguisher is located
- Ensure that windows can opened easily so that they can be used
- as an Escape Route if needed
- Keep all Flammable Liquids/Materials away from Ignition Sources and keep Lighters/Matches away from children
